

- (6) All the funds of the



A meeting of the IQAC of the college was held on 26.11.2024 at 3.00 p.m. in the Principal's office, chaired by respected Principal of the college Dr. R. C. Dhaluriaji.

Following points were discussed in the meeting :

- (1) The main focus of the meeting was to prepare a ppt of five minutes on best practices adopted by the college to be presented in Principal's conference with Hon'ble Education Minister Sh. Rohit Thakur, Education Secretary Sh. Raksh Kanwas and Director H.E. Dr. Amarjeet K. Sharma at Peter Hof Shimla on 30.11.2024 & 01.12.2024.
- (2) It was decided in the meeting that the ^(CC&PC) Guidance & Counselling & Placement Cell _{of the college} in collaboration with IQAC of the college will organise a one day workshop in third week of Dec. 2024 on "Crafting the Career After 12th Class" for future perspective of Senior Secondary students of the twelve adopted schools by the college (MOUs were signed with them).
- (3) Four to six meritorious students from each adopted school along with their faculty members will participate in the workshop. Ppt presentations of 10-15 minutes on subjects - Physics, Chemistry, Bio-Sciences, Maths, Commerce, Pol.Science, Economics & Languages etc. will be delivered during the course of this workshop, followed by question answer sessions and after that visit of Labs, Library, Gym, Canteen etc. by the students & faculty.
- (4) Refreshment will be given/served to each participant and faculty member out of conference fund. School faculty may interact with the college faculty for their better exposure towards academic, co-curricular, Cultural & Sports facilities available in the College.


Final Report on the International Conference

4. **Section D:** Alumni's feedback on curriculum.



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

6. Holistic Development of Students


Equal emphasis was given to academics, co-curricular activities, discipline, life skills, and social responsibility to ensure overall transformation of students.
