
DREAM, DECIDE, DO WORKSHOP FOR INFORMED CAREER DECISION MAKING AFTER 12th

One-Day Workshop for Students after 12th – Dream, Decide, Do on dated 23 Dec. 2024


On 27th September 2024


PREAMBLE:

The MoU is made Govt. Degree College Dharampur, District Mandi, Himachal Pradesh-175040 as one party, and Career Point University Hamirpur, Himachal Pradesh-UGC-recognized State Private University having its premises at Bhoranj (Tikker-Kharwarian), Hamirpur, (H.P)-176041, as the other party. Both parties through their authorized representatives which include its successors administrators 'executors assigns representatives and permitted assigns of one party/other party.

The need of close cooperation in research and academic activities has been realized by the University Grants Commission, Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Council of Scientific and Industrial Research and other Public or Private organizations between Universities and premier National Laboratories or institutes of the country. In order to enhance the level of cooperation between the two institutes (Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Govt. Degree College Dharampur and Career Point University) and to raise the standards of research and academic activities at each of these institutes, the volunteer need for sharing the laboratory and field facilities, faculty expertise, dissemination of technology in general and students research in particular is being actively felt. To accomplish these goals, both the Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Govt. Degree College Dharampur and Career Point University have agreed to enter into an MoU for collaborative research and academic activities of mutual interest on the terms and conditions specified below:

I. General:

The scope of the MoU will be to collaborate for research and teaching in the designated subjects of Basic Sciences, Humanities, Commerce BCA, PGDCA and Vocational Courses.

The aforesaid faculty and students of respective organization shall be provided with Photostat facilities on the same terms and conditions as are provided to their staff and research fellows.

As per the availability, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Govt. Degree College Dharampur Career Point University shall arrange Hostel/Guest House accommodation for students/faculty coming to respective institute for training/teaching as per extant guidelines of respective Institutes.

In all cases related to work under this MoU, T.A /D.A. for scientists/ faculty and research scholars invited as per need will be borne by the respective organizations.

2. Academic Programs:

Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Govt. Degree College Dharampur /Career Point University faculty will assist in the evaluation of student's performance of respective institutes in theory as well as practical classes.

3. Protection & Disposition of Ownership of Intellectual Property Rights

The ownership of all Background Information and Background Intellectual Property Rights generated by the parties prior to the MoU shall rest with the respective parties. However, parties shall have the right to use such Background Information and Background Intellectual Property Rights for the purposes of the R&D work performed under the MoU.

All Foreground Information and Foreground Intellectual Property Rights created during the joint R&D work performed under the MoU shall be owned jointly by both the parties.

Parties to this MoU shall confer and consult each other regarding filing of Intellectual Property Rights applications including patent applications covering Foreground Information and share equally the attendant expenditure related to filing, prosecution, grant, maintenance etc. of the same.

In the event of any extraordinary situation including infringement suits filed by third parties, parties shall initiate any action in mutual consultation and agreement.

8. Arbitration: Except as herein before provided, any dispute arising out of this MoU, the same shall be referred to Distt. Court Hamirpur (HP) and the decision of such court, as the case may be, shall be final and binding on both parties. The venue of arbitration shall be at Hamirpur (HP) and the arbitration proceedings shall take place under the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

9. It is agreed that the progress of this MoU shall be monitored by the Review Committee comprising of Vice-Chancellor, Career Point University and Principal Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Govt. Degree College Dharampur through periodic meetings.

This MoU is valid for a period of 5 (five) years starting from 17th January, 2024 subject to further extension on mutually agreed upon terms and conditions. Any mid-term change alteration in the terms and conditions of MoU as suggested by the Review Committee shall also be deemed to be valid for both the Institutions. Novem Controls Pvt Ltd, THE SECOND PARTY, and represented hereby its Zonal Executive Head, **Mr. Pushkar Rawat**, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", expression which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:
Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Govt. Degree College Dharampur
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests
- E) Novem Controls Pvt Ltd, the Second Party is engaged in Business, Manufacturing, Skill Development, Education and R&D Services in the fields of - **IOT, AI** and related fields.
- F) Novem Controls Pvt Ltd, the Second Party is engaged in the business of Manufacturing, Website Development, Software Development, Online Applications Development, Technical Consulting Services, Domain Name Reg. and Hosting Services, Bulk SMS Provider, and Industrial IT Training Facilities and Guidance Services.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS.



CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

- 1.1 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.2 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

- 2.3 **Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an

tin to the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

- 2.4 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of **Software Development, Web Development, and Product Development.**
- 2.5 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.6 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.7 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.8 **Placement of Trained Students:** Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements of the students. The Second Party will itself absorb the trained students.
- 2.9 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.
- 2.10 There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Govt. Degree College Dharampur** the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be

separately.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY
